<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Public authorities' and citizens' trust require to present concrete applications of new services, addressing relevant use cases and improving the daily life in the cities Public and private stakeholders need reasonable economic perspectives, beyond the usual benefits expected, but not yet proven Public authorities are reluctant to support new services that would require more subsidies, and need to optimize the existing financial support. Clear understanding of the value chain and the possible ecosystems will clarify the path towards market creation New stakeholders could support the development There is a risk that new mobility services compete with existing transport systems and destroys the existing balance. <p><i>Further arguments?</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Testing new services require adapted vehicle performances (safety, level of automation, speed of operation) which might not be available in sufficient numbers Regulatory framework might be missing Involvement of local authorities might not be strong enough for political reasons (election periods, switch in national policies or local priorities, lack in skills and dialogue with the citizens...)
