

GRVA - 3rd session

In June 2019 (3rd and 4th) it was held in Geneva a special meeting of the GRVA, the main objective of the meeting was to set the Terms of Reference of the new Informal Working Groups: Functional Requirements for Automated Driving (FRAV); Validation Methods for Automated and Autonomous Vehicles (VMAD); Task Force on Cyber Security and Software Updates, and finally a dedicated group for Data Storage Systems for Autonomous Driving and/or Event Data Recorder (DSSAD/EDR). It was also foreseen to revise the latest updates made by the Cyber Security and Software Updates task force.

The mandate of the Cyber Security and Software Updates task force was extended one additional year. Terms of Reference documents for the Functional Requirement, Validation Methods and Data Storage Systems/Event Data Recorders were developed during the session. Additionally, a discussion about the leadership of the IWGs was held, and some countries proposed candidates to chair the groups. It was agreed that these Terms of Reference would be approved, and the leadership of the groups would be decided during the WP.29 session in June.

Chair of the Cyber Security and Software Updates task force informed to the group about the latest updates made during the previous meetings. Main point of its presentation was about the test phase (not finished at this moment) and how it was being developed. At the end of the meeting it was set up the next steps and they confirmed to inform the group about the results of the test phase during the next GRVA session in September 2019.
